GROOMING OPERATOR / JOB DESCRIPTION

Description Summary

This position is primarily a snow grooming equipment operator whose duties include some maintenance and repairs, mobilizing and transporting equipment between venues, handling fuels and lubricants as well as updating the snowline and conditions reports. This position also provides support and service for LWSC Events and Promotions as requested.

Essential Functions

- Assist in the effort to open all LWSC venues as early as possible and maintain all venues to extend the season into March as weather permits
- Provide a consistent and world-class groomed ski product
- Safely operate and work around all equipment as trained and per manufacturer
- Safely handle all fuels, lubricants and other materials
- Safely transport grooming equipment to various venues as scheduled
- Maximize grooming efficiencies of Labor & Machine Expense Ratios
- Accurately log daily labor on timecard/timesheet and submit to manager for approval
- Maintain the cleanliness of all machines and equipment
- Assist in the training of other operators as requested
- Assist in the maintenance of all equipment as requested
- Update the phone snow report (509-548-5115) post-shift and before leaving
- Update the website snow report as instructed post-shift and before leaving
- Prepare the various venues according to the daily operating schedule and/or event program in a timely fashion and as requested
- Adhere to MSDS requirements applicable to the department

Experience / Requirements

- Minimum of two years snow grooming experience or equivalent equipment operating experience. Skiing/ski industry experience preferred
- Valid WSDL and able to meet the LWSC vehicle insurance requirements
- Command of the English language both written and verbal
- Working knowledge of PC computers is helpful
- Able to use good judgment and make sound decisions
- Able to pass a background check
- High School Graduate/GED minimum, College degree preferred
- Reliable all-weather transportation

Physical Requirements

- Stand and / or sit for extended periods, lift, reach, walk, bend and stoop
- Sit and articulate hands, arms and legs for extended period of times.
- Navigate uneven and or slippery equipment, terrain and conditions
- Lift up to 60 lbs.
- Tolerate hot/cold temperatures at times above 95 Degrees F or below 0 Degrees F

Working Conditions

- Indoor / Outdoor including extreme temperatures and snow / ice in the winter months
- Work primarily at night and early morning depending on weather conditions
- Works by themselves and must be able to function effectively with minimum supervision
- Noisy and exposed to fuels and lubricants
- Slippery grounds and equipment surfaces

Attendance

- Timely attendance as scheduled is paramount to successfully performing the job
- Business operation schedules and levels are affected by the weather, requiring the ability for this position to maintain flexibility in the work schedule
- This position's work schedule will also include weekends, holidays, nights, days and extra hours
